In an effort to prevent the spread of the Coronavirus (COVID-19), city officials have taken the following preventive measures for the safety of city employees, residents, and visitors. The preventative measures below follow the <u>Center for Disease Control</u> and <u>Mississippi State Department of Health</u> guidelines. These preventive measures are subject to change based on changes to federal and state guidelines.

- 1. All restaurant dining areas located in the city limits of Winona shall be closed and food services are limited to drive-thru, carry out, curbside delivery, or home delivery only.
- 2. The City of Winona has cancelled any and all public meetings, committee meetings, activities, gatherings, and events where over 50 people will be present.
- 3. Winona City Hall will be locked. All transactions will be processed at the drive-thru window or over the telephone. If you intend to make a credit card payment, please call 662-283-1232 instead of paying in person.
- 4. It is recommended that any and all private events and gatherings (i.e. bars, clubs, restaurants, etc.) where over 50 people will be present be cancelled and/or postponed.
- 5. It is recommended that anyone 65 years or older or anyone with severe medical conditions not be in or near crowds of over 50 people.
- 6. Precautions at gatherings should include proper hand hygiene, social distancing, and enhanced ventilation.
- 7. Do not visit a place where the virus is verified to be present and do not go into crowds and practice social distancing.
- 8. If you believe you have contracted COVID-19 contact appropriate health professionals and call ahead before visiting any clinic or hospital for specific-testing and visiting directions.
- 9. All City of Winona personnel should take proper precautions when making contact with the public.
- 10. City of Winona's parks, recreational centers, and facilities will be closed until April 07, 2020.
- 11. The City of Winona is suspending all city-funded, employee travel unless deemed necessary by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen.
- 12. The City of Winona is requesting that the public not attend City Board Meetings unless you are on the agenda for a presentation.
- 13. All City-owned buildings will be regularly sanitized, checked for sufficient amounts of soap and /or hand sanitizer, and paper towels.
- 14. It is strongly encouraged that people who have recently traveled self-quarantine for fourteen (14) days.
